

# Orange County

• Orange County, is the third largest of the 58 counties in the state of California. As of the 2010 census, the population of Orange County was 3,114,363. Its capital is Santa Ana, the second most populous city in the county. According to the U.S. Census Bureau, the county has a total area of 948 square miles.


The county has a population density of 3,871 people per square mile. Orange County is located in southern California. It is boarded to the north with Los Angeles County, northeast with San Bernardino County and Riverside County, and southeast with San Diego County. Orange County represents 8.12% of the total population of California. Of the 3,114,363 people in Orange County, 74.07% are White, 34.23% are Hispanic, 19.19% are Asian, and 3.2% are Two or More Races. The median resident age is 36 years, and 35 years in the whole state. The current growth rate of Orange County is 3.19%.

According to the U.S. census, the number of housing units in 2014 grew approximately 2% to 1,072,011 from 1,048,907 in 2010. As of the 2000 Census, of the 935,287 households, 37.0% had children under the age of 18 living with them, 55.9% married couples were living together, 10.7% had a female householder with no husband present, and 28.6% were non-families. 21.1% of all households were made up of individuals and 7.2% had someone living alone who was 65 years of age or older. The average household size was two people, compared to three for the whole state. The 2013 household median income was \$74,163, compared tos \$60,190 in the whole state.


The Orange County unemployment rate averaged to 4.1% in April 2015. Orange County is the headquarters of many Fortune 500 companies including Ingram Micro (#69) and First American Corporation (#312) in Santa Ana, Broadcom (#343) in Irvine, Western Digital (#439) in Lake Forest and Pacific Life (#452) in Newport Beach. Irvine is the home of numerous start-up companies and also is the home of Fortune 1000 headquarters for Allergan, Edwards Lifesciences, Epicor, Standard Pacific and Sun Healthcare Group.



Locator Map







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

#### Description

BJ's Restaurants, Inc. is an American restaurant chain, headquartered in Huntington Beach, California.Some locations feature microbreweries that supply beer to other locations in the chain. The chain operates under the names BJ's Restaurant & Brewery, BJ's Restaurant & Brewhouse, BJ's Grill, and BJ's Pizza & Grill. BJ's menu features pizza, its own handcrafted beers, as well as a selection of appetizers, entrees, pastas, sandwiches, specialty salads and desserts

BJ's was founded in 1978 and first opened in Santa Ana, California, as BJ's Chicago Pizzeria[3] by Mike Phillips and Bill Cunningham.Phillips and Cunningham sold their company to their accountants Paul Motenko and Jerry Hennessy in 1991.

By 1996, seven restaurants had opened between San Diego and Los Angeles. Originally known as Chicago Pizza, the company went public about 1996, raising \$9.4 million. The company then bought 26 Pietro's Pizza restaurants in March 1996 in a \$2.8 million deal in cash and assumed debt, but then sold off seven of the locations with plans to convert the remaining Pietro's to what was then BJ's Pizza. During the same year, the company opened a microbrewery at its Brea restaurant.

Between 2010 and 2011, the National Retail Federation named it as one of the 10 fastest growing restaurants in the U.S. based on year-over-year sales.

As of March 4, 2011, BJ's operates 103 restaurants located in 13 states (California, Texas, Arizona, Colorado, Oregon, Nevada, Florida, Ohio, Oklahoma, Kentucky, Indiana, Louisiana and Washington).

In October 2012, Greg Trojan became President and CEO.

In 2013, BJ's produced a combined total of 60,000 barrels annually at their 11 brewery restaurants to serve their chain of 136 restaurants in 15 states.[11] In 2010, the company's BJ's Hefelightzen was awarded a gold medal at the Great American Beer Festival.

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




#### 2020 Household Income




#### 2020 Population by Race
